Turtle Season is here and we'd like to remind everyone that 9:00 p.m. is lights out for any lights that illuminate the beach. This affects owners and guests in the E Building. Lanai lights need to be turned off and your vertical blinds need to be closed. This is in compliance with the Land Development Code Regulations. For weekly sea turtle nesting results visit <http://www.colliergov.net/esd>. Turtle season runs from May 1st to October 31st of each year.

As you prepare for your summer vacation here in beautiful Marco Island, please include the weather channel as part of your trip preparation. While the weather here is mostly beautiful, this is the time of year that we keep an eye on the tropics. In September we will begin concrete restoration work to 6 lanais. These repairs were identified by our structural engineer during a structural inspection. The work will be done during Supermaintenance weeks which are weeks 37 and 38.

Please be aware that on the Island, North Collier Boulevard is currently undergoing significant road improvements which require the periodic re-routing of traffic. **Road construction in front of the resort has been completed.** While these situations are out of our control we do apologize in advance for any inconveniences you may experience as a result.
